Having more than **30 years** of experience in the **Sugar Industry**, Mr David MARJOLIN began his career in an **Industry 3.0 automated production** environment which has served as a stepping stone to the subsequent business-driven IT leverage. He is among the initiators of the blueprinting process for **Industry 4.0 adoption**.

Mr MARJOLIN, with an **MBA** from the University of Surrey and an **MSc** in IT/Business Information Systems from Keele University, is currently the **IT Manager** of **Alteo Agri Ltd** and prior to the merger, **Deep River Beau Champ Ltd**, for the last 16 years.

With a turnover of Rs 8.93 billion for 2017, Alteo is the **largest sugar producer** in Mauritius with a strong presence in Africa. Alteo operates three sugar factories in **Mauritius, Tanzania** and **Kenya**. In 2016/17, the Group produced 300,000 tonnes of raw sugar and 167,000 tonnes of refined white sugar.
